TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, characteristic trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 8 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, nectar value 5, pollen value 5

Flowers: panicle, striking, standing, big | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** August - September | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, polished, pinnate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, capsule | **Fruit colour:** red-violet, black | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy
