Location: street, avenue, square, car park / parking lot, park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, countryside | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: ovoid | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 6 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: corymbose, standing, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** daffodil | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** buds red, green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, small | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, drupe | **Fruit colour:** grey-green | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown, green
