Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind \| Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil| Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients \| Soil moisture level: very dry, dry, moist | Light requirements: sun | pH range: neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat
