USE

Location: street, avenue, park, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** March - March | **Leaf colour:** dark green, buds bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** winged, nut | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown
