Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals, humans, nectar value 3, pollen value 3

Flowers: bell-shaped, small | **Flower colour:** white-pink | **Flowering period:** May - August | **Leaf colour:** green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** evergreen, obovate, small, leathery, polished | **Fruits:** edible, small, berry | **Fruit colour:** red | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** hairy
