


Vinca minor 'Alba'

TYPES OF PLANTING

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, Landscape planting, shade-tolerant, Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Height: 0.1 - 0.25 m | **Width:** 0.2 - 0.3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** neutral (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution
