TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** ground cover

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 1.5 - 2.5 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (6.1 - 7.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, singular, big, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green, buds pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, rough, serrate, crenate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, small, raceme, berry | **Fruit colour:** red, black | **Bark colour:** pale brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, horizontal branches | **Root system:** deep, extensive
