TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: multi-stemmed trees, solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 2 - 2.5 m | **Width:** 2 - 2.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline (5.5 - 8.0) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, spherical, striking, singular, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white, white-pink | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, polished, underside hairy | **Fruits:** discrete, berry | **Fruit colour:** red, black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** cinnamon-brown | **Twigs:** hairy | **Root system:** shallow
