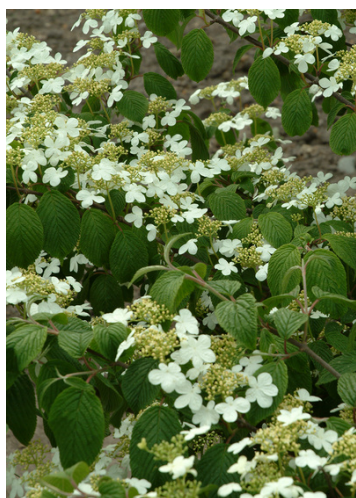


Viburnum plicatum f. *tomentosum*



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 3 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, lanceolate, big, serrate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** striking, berry | **Fruit colour:** red, black | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Twig colour:** red-brown
