Tree types: half-stem trees, characteristic trees, fruit trees | **Other types of planting:** climbing plants | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: weeping | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, small mammals, birds, humans

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, discrete | **Flower colour:** cream | **Flowering period:** March - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, lobate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-orange | **Fruits:** striking, edible, large | **Fruit colour:** blue | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown
