**Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 10 - 15 m | **Width:** 10 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 9A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds, small mammals

**Flowers:** infundibular, scented | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** lanceolate, composite | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** striking, berry | **Fruit colour:** black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** thorned
